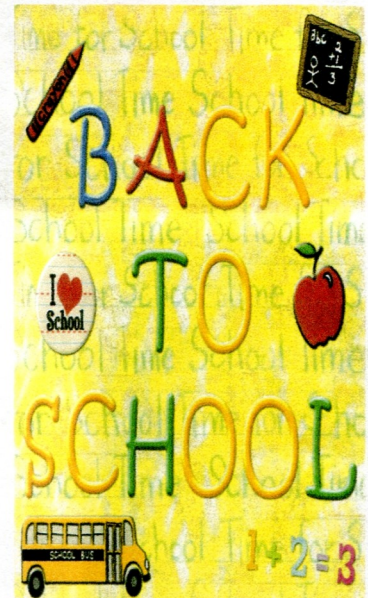

 Should I be shot; My soul please take! Amen

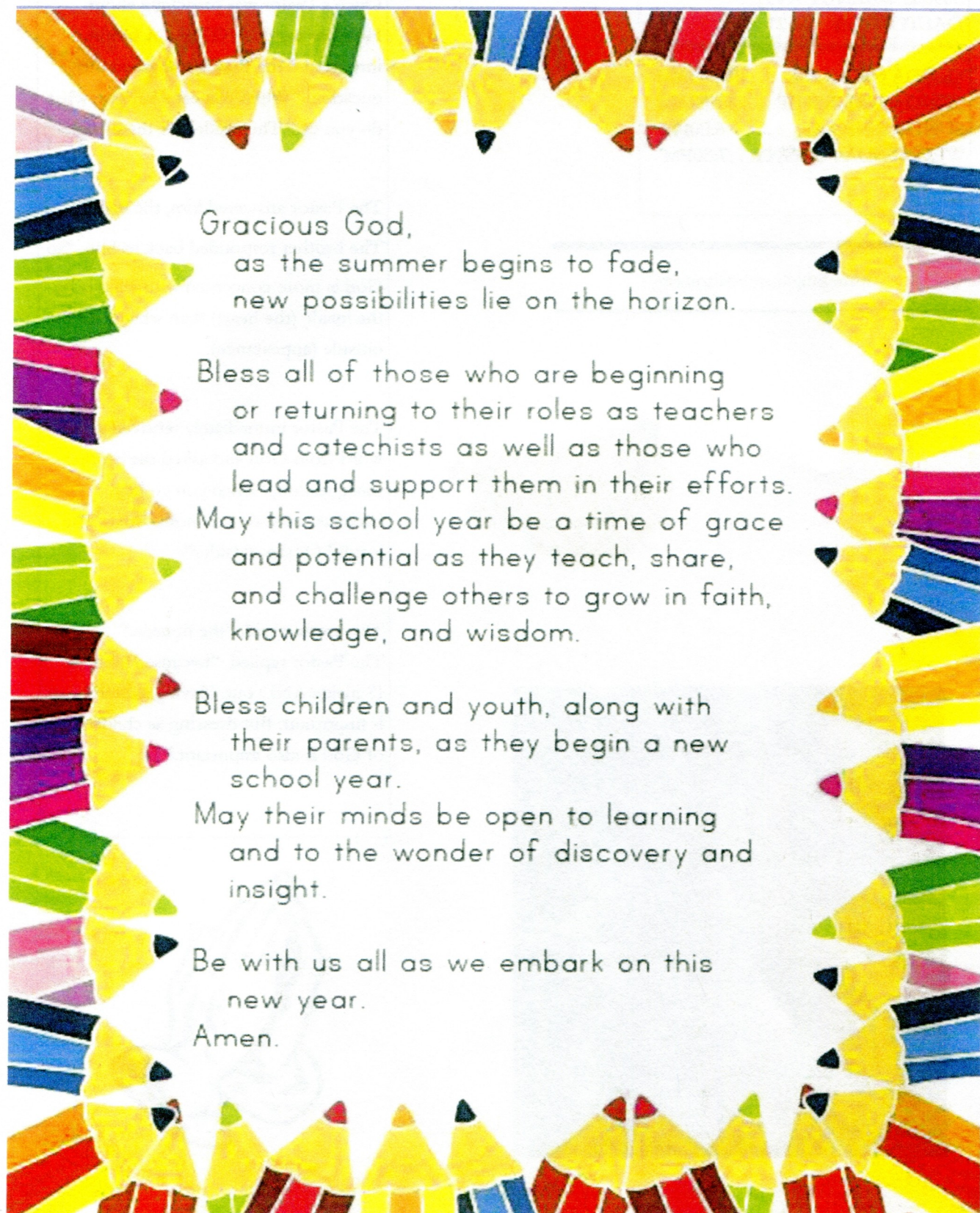

knowledge, and wisdom.

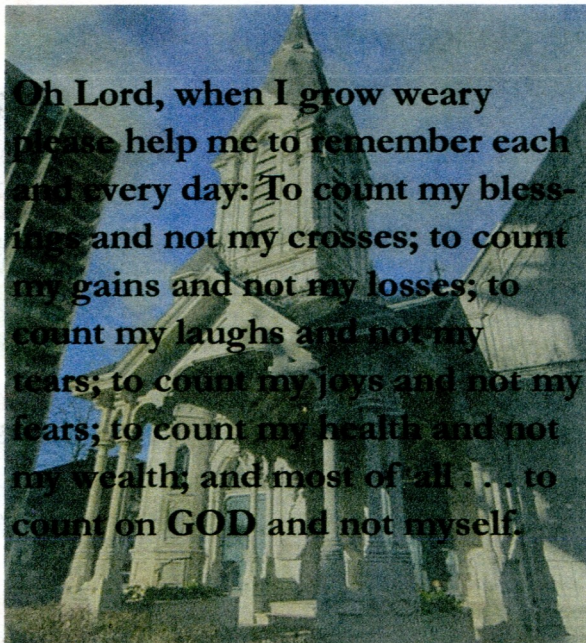
Bless children and youth, along with
