PRAYER

Do you ever find it difficult to pray? Maybe you struggle to find the right words, or you cannot stop your mind from wandering. Maybe you do not think what you have to say is important enough or eloquent enough. One day Jesus' disciples asked Him to teach them to pray, and He began His prayer with two simple words, "Our Father." Simple, but profound when you consider the implications. With these two words, Jesus was making a bold declaration. God is our Father, and we all belong to Him.

Consider the following story:

One day, a father was sitting with his 3-year-old son at the dinner table. Little Solomon looked up into his father's face and said, "I love you, Daddy."

The father smiled and said, "How much do you love me Solomon?"

The little fellow stretched out his chubby, little arms as far apart as he could and said, "This big!"

"Then," said the father, "if you love Daddy that big, you jump up and bring me a drink of water." Solomon jumped up and ran over to the water pot, but the water pot was too high! For just a moment he looked at it, and then looked at the tin cup that hung on a nail near the water pot; but it was too high also. then without hesitation he stood on his tip-toes, with his little stomach pressed flat against the post and his little arm reaching toward the cup. Little Solomon could just barely touch it. But, even doing all he could, only Solomon's little finger could make the cup slightly move. Solomon called to his father, Daddy, Daddy, Daddy!"

Joy filled the father's face as he quickly rose from the table and walked over to his little boy. Then lifted him in his arms till his little hand could reach the cup and dip the water. Then he put little Solomon on the floor again, and the little boy took the cup of water to the table. The father took a long

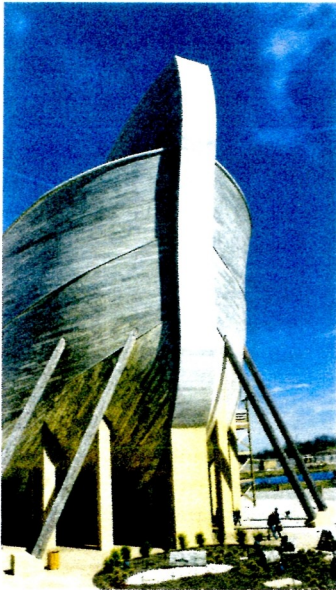
drink of the water and exclaimed, "That's the sweetest cup of water I've ever had in all my life!"
