I tried not to stare but as I looked closer I could clearly see they were burn scars.

I then looked at her face as she was handing out drinks to all of us at the table and I saw sadness. Her eyes didn't sparkle and she looked tired.

Was it because of her burns? What/who caused them? When did she get them? Was she abused? All the questions were echoing in my mind as I was trying to figure out "how" she got the scars.

But I stopped trying to figure out how she got them. It didn't matter. I looked her in the eye and made contact with her and I smiled and tried to convey to her that I was her friend.

Don't forget when you're in a restaurant to be kind, smile and look your waitress/waiter in the eyes. Talk to them as if they

were your son, daughter, granddaughter/grandson.

The 1-2 hours you're there could be the only "Jesus" they'll ever encounter!

Take notice of people around you. Be the light in their darkness. We don't have to beat people over the head with a Bible to show the gospel to them! If you're wearing a "I love Jesus" shirt while at the Red Lobster you'd better prove it in your words and actions!

When you look at someone with love and compassion and talk to them with kindness and a genuine concern for them they'll see and feel the love of Jesus!

Pray to have the eyes, ears and heart of Jesus to look beyond what's in front of you!

You want to minister? Pray for Godly "encounters" ...Pray for "God moments" ...for it is those encounters and moments where you will experience what the true work of the gospel is! It is then when you'll see Jesus

and He'll humble and mold you to be His mouth, hands and feet.

Ministry isn't just a platform it's an every day walk and talk! It's servanthood. It's washing the feet of others without needing a pan of water!
