There's a lesson in a pan of homemade buttermilk biscuits.

If you take 2 cups of self rising flour alone it doesn't taste good. And it would be to much to try to eat it alone. Then take a half cup of Crisco, no one would dare eat that alone. Add 1 cup of buttermilk. Some do enjoy drinking it by itself. Add a pinch or 2 of salt. Not many just pour salt in their mouth. Then the 1/4 cup of butter that goes on top. We are not about to just drink melted butter. And none of us want to be placed in a hot 450 degree oven.

But when you take that flour, you work in your Crisco. Then add your buttermilk and pinch of salt. Put it in a hot skillet and pour melted butter on it. Place it in a 450* oven. What comes out is a delicious, flaky delight.

You see our life is like that. The ingredients that we get at times are hard to digest. And each aspect within itself may not seem appealing to the eye. But when God takes it all and mixes it together. It comes together and works for our good.

So no matter what stage you're in right now. If your ingredients are being gathered one by one. Or you may be in the mixing process. You might be in your time of extreme heat! Just trust God's process and plan.
